# Idea election



## Why play this game?

Develops quick thinking and idea generation and shares the expertise in the room.

#### How does it work?

- 1. Four participants are selected to take part in the game.
- 2. Game Leader announces the overall topic for the game (word pictures, competition speaking, best looking National Education Directors etc)
- 3. Game Leader then reads out categories related to the game topic from a card (1 category per card)
- 4. Each time the participants come up with an example of the category (up to 30 seconds to describe their idea).
- 5. The people not taking part in the game then vote for which idea they like best.
- 6. The winner each round gets the card and at the end of the game the participant with the most cards wins!

#### What do we need?

Cards with categories and someone keeping score.

### Let's mix it up!

- If the voting can be instantaneous (through pointing at people) then the game participants can take part in the voting as well. No voting for yourself!
- Make the game "elimination style" so that every round the participant with the least votes is removed from the game.
